




SKOWHEGAN COMPOST POLICY

COMPOST POLICY: This Policy is to give guidance with regard to the distribution of the compost that the Town of Skowhegan produces.

1. All Town Departments will have first refusal on any and all compost.
2. The Highway Department will supply a small amount for the use of the residents. This will be supplied free for the taking at the Highway Department. This will not be available for contractors or residents of other towns; and will be monitored by the Highway Department and the Police Department. No Highway equipment or staff will be used to load this compost and all liability falls on the resident that is taking the compost.
3. Excess Compost: Once it has been determined that all Town Department needs have been met, any large quantities of excess compost will be stored at the Transfer Station and put out for bid. The bid procedure will be in accordance with the Purchasing Policy, with the bid being awarded to the highest bidder. This Policy does give a 10% preference to local bidders.
4. The Town will load all compost at a cost of \$1.00 per yard in addition to the bid price. This will be done at a scheduled time, during regular business hours, that is convenient for the Transfer Station. All Equipment and vehicles used by the bidder must be registered, insured and inspected prior to being allowed to pick up any material.

by unanimous vote on this 27th day of July, 2010.
