Municipal Officers' Notice of Public Hearing**

TO: David Bucknam, a constable of the Town of Skowhegan: In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify the voters of the Town of Skowhegan of the Public Hearing described in this Notice of Public Hearing.

TO: The voters of the Town of Skowhegan:

Take notice that a public hearing will be held on **October 16, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Skowhegan Opera House** in the Municipal Building, 225 Water Street in Skowhegan on the following article which will be the subject of a referendum vote on November 6, 2018.

Article 2: Shall the Town authorize the Board of Selectmen to issue general obligation bonds or notes in the name of the Town in an amount not to exceed \$8,500,000, which bonds or notes may be made callable, to construct and equip a public safety building on Town land located on East Madison Road (a portion of Tax Map 4, Lot 4-3)?

2. **Estimated Debt Service Costs:** At an estimated interest rate of 3.33 %, the estimated costs to finance this Project over a term of 20 years are:


Principal:	\$ 8,500,000.00

Total Debt Service to be paid through maturity:	\$11,699,368.00

3. **Validity:** The validity of the bonds and the voters' ratification of the bonds may not be affected by any errors in the above estimates. If the actual amount of the total debt service or the bond issue varies from the estimate, the ratification by the electors is nevertheless conclusive and the validity of the bond issue is not affected by reason of the variance.




