## Skowhegan Second Bridge Feasibility Study

The Town of Skowhegan is partnering with the Maine Department of Transportation on a Joint Planning Study to look at the feasibility of a second bridge over the Kennebec River in Skowhegan. The Study Team has been evaluating current conditions and future alternatives and has considered public input provided at our first Public Input Meeting on September 10, 2019.

At this meeting we will do two things: (1) The Study Team will present findings to date and alternatives for going forward, (2) The public will ask questions and provide input.
