


# Q1 Do you understand why new police and fire facilities are needed?



## Q2 Do you feel that there is a benefit to have police and fire facilities in one building?



### Q3 How important is it to you to have the Skowhegan Police Department located downtown?





**Q5 In order to have facilities located in downtown Skowhegan, are you willing to build as two separate projects (police station and fire station) even if the resulting facilities will cost more?**








