Re: Important Notice

Dear Madison Ave. Commercial St., Water St. Area Residents,

We are writing to you today to inform you of water utility work in your area that is scheduled to begin very soon. We will be completing the replacement of the water main and services on Madison Ave. and Commercial St. The project will begin around June 5th and will last for approximately 6 weeks. Most of this work will be completed during the night from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM to minimize traffic disruptions.

Maine Water will be running temporary water lines to the affected homes to keep you with water during construction. These temporary lines will be on top of the ground during this project.

We also want to inform you that the construction area may present additional hazards, such as open trenches, roadway depressions or bumps that require caution. The contractor will have appropriate signs, barricades and lighting to ensure our construction zones are as safe as possible. However, we understand that construction zones present an unusual attraction, especially to children, and we ask you to avoid any open excavations and take all necessary precautions if you visit the project area. Traffic will be affected and may be reduced to one lane at times.

The purpose of this work is to replace the aging infrastructure. This will also improve water quality and flows in the area. Feel free to call our office if you have any questions about the project.
