


And Your Direct Dependents:

- Dependents can receive the same services that are available to farmworkers. If dependents are between 18-24 years old, they can also receive services related to post-secondary education.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- Photo ID
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- Marriage Certificate (if applicable)
- Evidence of time as farmworker
- Evidence of other income (Stamps, TANF, Child Support, Unemployment, etc.

*** These documents are also required for dependents of farmworkers.

This program is funded, in part, by the Employment and Training Administration of the United States Department of Labor, with a funding allocation of \$432,000.

Program Mission:

The objective of the National Farmworker Jobs Program is to help agricultural workers and direct dependents to train in different occupational areas and find full-time work.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Work or have worked in agriculture in any period within the past 24 months.
- Be a legal spouse or direct dependent of an agricultural worker.
- If you are not a direct dependent of any agricultural worker, you must be able to demonstrate that you were claimed on the income form as a dependent or be able to establish a direct relationship with the agricultural worker:
 - Child, grandchild, great-grandchild
 - Adoptive children
 - Sibling, half-sibling, step-sibling
 - Father, mother, grandparents, or some other direct descendent.
- Meet income guidelines set by US Department of Labor.
- Be a US citizen, permanent resident, refugee, parolee, or immigrant authorized to work in the US (Not H2A).
- Be over 18 years old.
- Be registered with the Selective Service (only males born after 1960).
- Want to train and find full-time work
