
- Your address with zip code

Direct Deposit: Disaster assistance funds can be sent directly to your bank account. Please provide your bank account type, account number and bank routing number.

Stay in touch with FEMA: When you apply, you will receive a FEMA registration number. Save it. You will need the number whenever you contact FEMA.

Disaster Recovery Center Locations

If you suffered disaster-related damage to your home or rental unit, personal property or business and have questions about available assistance, visit your nearest DRC.

You can do the following at any location:

- Check the status of your application.
- Meet with a FEMA applicant assistance representative.
- Obtain information from state agencies and voluntary organization.
- Discuss U.S. Small Business Administration’s (SBA) low-interest disaster loans for businesses, non-profit organizations, homeowners and renters and receive help inputting your application or documents.
- Obtain information about additional resources available and how to reduce future damage.
- Download the FEMA App for DRC Days/Hours and Locations on your Apple or Android device.
