### Disaster Recovery Center in Manchester to Close March 4, New Center to Open in Farmingdale March 6

**SOUTH PORTLAND, Maine** - The Disaster Recovery Center located at the Manchester Fire Department, 37 Readfield Rd. will close Monday, March 4 at 5 p.m.

A new center will open at the Farmingdale Fire Department, 571 Maine Ave. on Wednesday, March 6 through Wednesday, March 20, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Disaster Recovery Centers are operated by FEMA and the State of Maine to help those affected by the December 17-21, 2023 severe storm and flooding apply for FEMA assistance, submit documents needed for their application and get answers to questions in person.
